POSITION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Profile Theatre seeks House Managers for the upcoming production of *The Oldest Profession* at the Barge Building at Zidell Yards.

Training and supervising volunteer ushers, ensuring Covid-compliance, greeting guests, responding to patron questions and needs, ensuring all guests are seated in an orderly manner, communicating with stage management when the house is ready to be seated and when seating is complete, light tidying of house after performance concludes, etc.

QUALIFICATIONS

The ideal candidate will have experience working house management for a professional theatre.

Must be comfortable with technology and working closely with other individuals.

JOB DESCRIPTION

House Manager

Responsible for the coordination and logistics of front of house and audience experience for The Oldest Profession at Old Moody Stages. Responsibilities include:

- Training and supervising volunteer ushers
- Managing audience seating
- Coordinating with box office
- Coordinating show and intermission start and stop times with stage management
- Managing late seating
- Problem solving any audience or volunteer issues that arise
- Light cleaning of seating and lobby areas
- Answering audience and volunteer questions
- Opening and closing the venue
